RECITAL & COSTUMES

Our annual recital will be a *Celebration of 20 Years of Dance* and held on June 8 -10 at Plachta Auditorium in Warriner Hall at CMU. All dancers will perform in at least two shows. We have many families with more than one dancer. We promise to do our very best when trying to keep dancers in the same recitals. Keep in mind that sometimes dancers perform in additional shows to make sure they are in the same shows with their siblings. Most dancers do participate, however, if you can not participate you must inform us no later than December 31. Please look ahead for possible conflicts such as family weddings, etc. We will schedule our shows by April and we cannot change for one person since so many have been considered in the initial planning stages. **NO COSTUME WILL BE ORDERED UNLESS IT IS PAID IN FULL.** It takes 12-14 weeks to receive, check in and distribute costumes so they must be ordered early to guarantee receiving the specific costume chosen. Costume billings will not be mailed home.

FOR LEARNING'S SAKE

Studio Guidelines Designed to

Make Your Classes More Fun and Safe

1. If your on time your late. Please arrive early enough to be ready to dance when your class starts. Please no more than 15 minutes.
2. Please help keep the studio clean by picking up after yourself.
 - Please put your clothes and bag in a cubby or in the locker room.
 - **STREET SHOES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE STUDIOS**
 - **ONLY WATER, NO OTHER FOOD/DRINK IN THE STUDIOS**
3. Proper attire for class is expected.
 - Is your hair up? Do you have the right shoes?
 - No Jewelry. No chewing gum.
 - Proper dress for ballet is a leotard & tights. **NO Jazz Pants**
4. Is your name in ALL of your things? Please put your name in everything so it can be identified if it is left at the studio!
5. Students are asked not to leave class to use the restroom. Please go before/after class or at home.
6. Replace all tap shoe ribbons with black elastic. Purchase regular 1/4 inch and make a bow or sew a loop together. Thanks!
7. Children under 11 cannot be left alone at the studio while not participating in class.
8. Attendance is expected. We have an optional make-up class available for every class held during the week. If you have to miss for any reason, the make-up class lists are at the front desk.
9. Feel free to watch through the observation windows, but refrain from any distracting behavior.
10. Students may not have gum or wear jewelry in class for safety.
11. If any dancer or her/his family is destructive to DDD property the dancers guardian is responsible for the damages.
12. No tap shoes are allowed in the locker room/restrooms.
13. No food is allowed in the locker room.
14. Please be sure you and the people with you are quiet and well behaved in the lobby. No running, screaming or horseplay of any kind is allowed. If unacceptable behavior is not corrected they will be asked to leave

USED SHOE & APPAREL SALES

If you are interested in selling your used shoes or dancewear in the studio you must follow this procedure.

Place your used shoes in a sealed zip lock bag with a self addressed stamped envelope with a card making note of the brand and size, your name and the price. Shoes that are left in the shoe sale area that are not properly packaged and labeled will be removed. If you have shoes you would like to give away place your used shoes in a sealed zip lock bag with a card making note of the brand and size and state they are FREE. All apparel must be marked and in a zip lock bag or on a hanger.

If you are purchasing a pair of used shoes, as you are trying shoes on make sure to keep each pair of shoes together with its zip lock bag and information. If you find a pair you would like to purchase place a CHECK or MONEY ORDER in the self addressed stamped envelope and turn it in to the front desk.
